I am writing to request preapproval for continued Adoption Subsidy therapy coverage for my children. Tyrone and Tamara were adopted by my husband and me through Foster Care in June 2014, at which time they were both approved for Adoption and Medical Subsidy, including coverage for psychotherapy. Since they came into care, Tyrone and Tamara have been working with their current therapist to treat Complex PTSD, which resulted from the severe emotional, physical, and sexual abuse they suffered before coming into Foster Care.

We understand that the subsidy office would prefer that we only apply for subsidy coverage after Medicaid benefits have been exhausted. We have already billed Medicaid for 20 visits this calendar year, which is the maximum number of visits they will cover. Since our Medicaid benefit has been exhausted we must rely upon Adoption Subsidy for coverage to meet our childrens' therapeutic needs for the rest of the year.
